


Resident Room: Discharge Cleaning



Getting Started



Ensure cart is loaded properly.



Place wet floor sign at

Remove all linens and place

in soiled linen liner.

Report any room issues.



Conduct hand hygiene, don gloves. Put on additional PPE as required (goggles).



Remove trash and infectious waste.



Patient Personal Belongings. If present, have nursing staff remove any patient belongings



High dust horizontal surfaces and fixtures.



Spot clean visible soil from low touch surfaces.
