

Application Procedures












Extract carpet and groom with a clean carpet rake or stiff synthetic broom. Allow to drv.



Use Extraction SC as a prespray, bonnet buff or extraction cleaner.



Vacuum carpet first. Fill extractor solution tank with Extraction SC from dispenser. As needed, pre-spot with the appropriate spotter. Extract following equipment maker's operating instructions.




Use PERdiemTM/MC General Purpose Cleaner with Hydrogen Peroxide to clean hard surfaces as well as carpet.



Fill mop bucket, spray bottle or automatic scrubbing machine from dispenser. Apply to surfaces to be cleaned. For use as a carpet spotter, prespray or extraction cleaner, apply to carpet, agitate and rinse with water. For autoscrubber use, trail mop behind machine to pick up any excess solution. Allow to dry.



Use Heavy Duty Prespray SC as prespray to loosen heavily soiled carpets.



Vacuum area first. Spray carpet and agitate with a carpet rake, extractor brush, shampoo brush or bonnet. Extract and allow to dry.



Use Crew® Non-Acid Bowl and Bathroom Disinfectant Cleaner to clean restroom toilets, sinks, floors and walls.



Apply use-solution to hard, nonporous surfaces. Thoroughly wet surface with a cloth, mop, sponge, sprayer or by immersion. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes. Wipe dry or allow to air dry.



UseCrew®Tile and GroutRejuvenatorto remove soap scum, stains and hard water deposits.



Spray cleaner using full strokes 6–8" from the surface. Wait until stains disappear and wipe excess with a cloth or sponge, rinse the area thoroughlywith cold water. Fortough stainsapply the cleaner and agitate the area with a stiff bristled brush, let the cleaner stand for 15 minutes. Rinse with cold water and repeat as needed.



Use Crew® Bathroom Cleaner and Scale Remover as a non-corrosive formula deep cleans dirt and soap scum from bathroom and shower tiles, fixtures and most washable surfaces.
