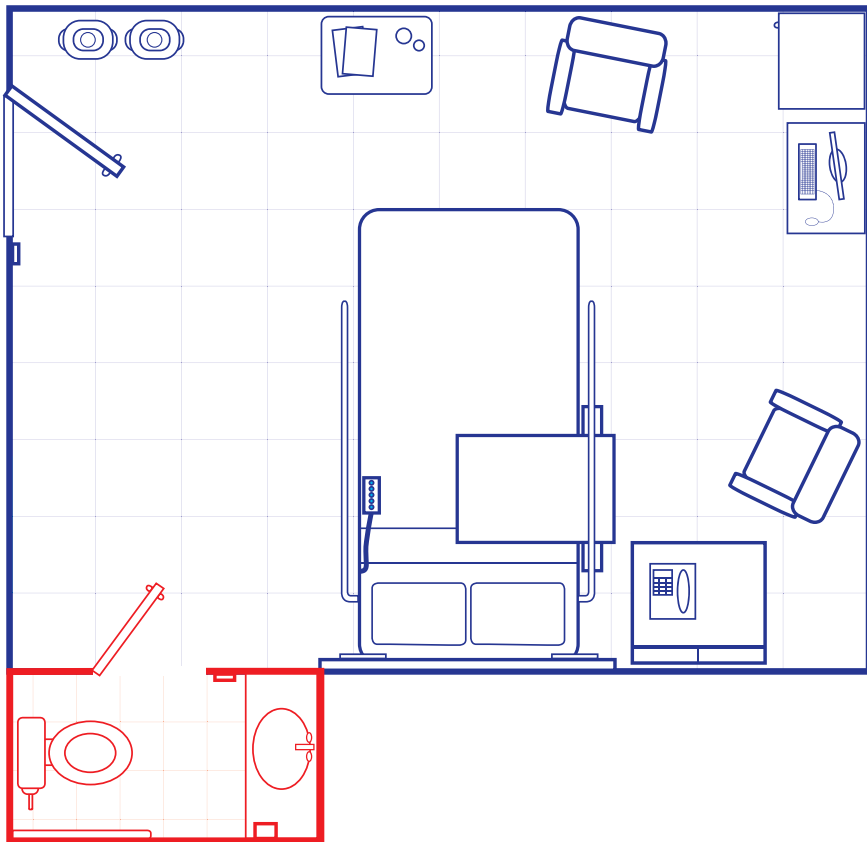


Patient Room: Daily Cleaning



Getting Started

- Gather supplies.
- Conduct hand hygiene, put on PPE.
- Place wet floor sign at the room entrance.
- Inspect the room and report any issues.
- Patient's Personal Belongings - If present, have nursing staff remove.
- Remove trash and infectious waste.
- Check sharps container - if over 2/3 full, call to have container replaced.
- High dust horizontal surfaces and fixtures.
- Spot clean visible soil from low touch surfaces such as walls.

Clean and Disinfectant Patient Room Surfaces

Entry Areas

- Gather cleaning wipe moistened with disinfectant; As the wipe becomes soiled, exchange it for a new wipe
- PPE Holder
- Soap/Sanitizer dispenser
- Door knob

Patient Area

- Light switch
- Sharps containers (exterior)
- Nurse server
- Computer monitor, mouse, keyboard and cart
- Patient and Visitor chairs
- Bedside table, inside drawer and drawer pulls
- Telephone
- Over bed tray table; do not disturb patient's belongings
- Call button/ TV remote
- Patient bed rails and controls
- IV pole grab area, do not disturb any medication
- Patient room closet (exterior and door pulls)
- Trash and infectious waste receptacles - clean inside and out and reline

Restroom Area

- Gather cleaning cloth moistened with disinfectant; As the cloth becomes soiled, exchange it for a new cloth
- Spray toilet bowl, seat and wall area with disinfectant; let dwell
- Restroom door and handles - inside and out
- Light switch
- Sink, faucets, and handles
- Soap/sanitizer dispenser
- Shower area
- Toilet grab handles/bar
- Pull cord
- Wall area around toilet
- Toilet Flush Handle
- Bed pan sprayer
- Toilet seat and bowl
- Clean commode, contact nursing before cleaning
- Remove gloves, conduct hand hygiene, put on new gloves

Finishing Area

- Refill tissue and towel dispensers
- Refill hand hygiene dispensers
- Rearrange furniture and equipment as required
- Inspect your work
- Mop floors
- Remove gloves and conduct hand hygiene
